JOINERVILLE PARK RULES:

In order that we may continue to provide adequate outdoor recreational opportunities in the future we ask that you and your party adhere to the following rules: VIOLATIONS MAY RESULT IN REVOCATION OF CAMPING PRIVILEGES AND/OR A CITATION.

- 1. A photo of your camping unit is required. If you have a pop up camper or you are tent camping applicant needs to provide a rental contract or proof of a portable restroom facility.
- 2. Camping limit is 14 days per site.
- 3. Four (4) adults or one (1) family per site. Family is defined by a max of 2 adults and minor children that reside under the same household.
- 4. Camping permits must be obtained from the conservation office 30 days prior to camping. All permits must be approved by the Jackson County Conservation Board.
- 5. Only a member of the camping party can obtain a camping permit. Camping party must be 18 years of age or older.
- 6. The camping party must have permit on site and be able show permit if asked.
- 7. Registered campers must be at the campsite during the overnight period.
- 8. All visitors must vacate the park area by 10:30 PM.
- 9. Check out time is 3:00 PM on the day following the camping permit.
- 10. Carry in, carry out all trash/refuse. You are responsible for leaving the site litter free, including fire ring. **Cancellations** need to be made within **24 hours** prior to **permit date** by calling the conservation office at 563.652.3783. After hours, please leave a detailed message. If you fail to cancel your permit you will be responsible for the campsite including damages and/or trash removal.

In case of emergency: Call 911.

For non-emergencies (to contact a Park Ranger or Deputies): Call Jackson County Sheriff's dispatch at 563.652.2468

Applicant agrees to leave the used site in the same condition as found, cleaning up all litter and debris after event. Applicant is responsible for any damages to county property during the event either by participants or spectators. Applicant agrees to abide by all state laws and Jackson County Conservation Board rules and regulations.

The undersigned applicant for a special event permit understands and agrees that neither the Jackson County Conservation Board or Jackson County will be responsible for any injury to persons or damage to property arising out of or incident to the activities which are the subject of this application.
