

JACKSON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 151 00 MAY -8 AM 11:07
"AN ORDINANCE TO SET THE SPEED LIMIT ON COUNTY ROAD
211th AVENUE FROM THE INTERSECTION OF 211TH Ave. PHYLIS M. GERLACH
STREET LOCATED IN JACKSON COUNTY, IOWA, T-84-N, RECORDER
R-3-E, SECTIONS 30 AND PROCEEDING NORTH 228.43 FEET FROM No Fee
THE SOUTH ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 30, T84N, R3E TO THE END OF
211TH AVENUE. SHALL BE POSTED 25 MPH."

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County, Iowa realizes that some locations in the County require lower speed limits than those set by State Legislature, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 321.285 of the Code of Iowa, an engineering study and traffic investigation at this location was conducted by the Jackson County Engineer, and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board of Supervisors has received the County Engineer's recommendation concerning the speed limit at this location and concurs with said recommendation:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Jackson County Board of Supervisorsthat the following speed limit be and are hereby set ON COUNTY ROAD 211th AVENUE FROM THE INTERSECTION OF 211TH Ave. and 17th STREET LOCATED IN JACKSON COUNTY, IOWA, T-84-N, R-3-E, SECTIONS 30 AND PROCEEDING NORTH 228.43 FEET FROM THE SOUTH ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 30, T84N, R3E TO THE END OF 211TH AVENUE SHALL BE POSTED 25 MPH."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer of Jackson County, Iowa, be directed to place signs setting the assigned speed limit of 25 211th AVENUE from intersection of 17th Street, North 228.43 feet from the South ¼ corner of section 30, T84N, R3E. The County Engineer will give proper notification to all concerned parties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any violation of this ordinance shall be a scheduled violation as provided in Section 805.8 (G) Iowa Code 1997
