JACKSON COUNTY ORDINANCE # 74

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES REGULATIONS ON PLUGGING AND CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS FOR PRIVATE WATER WELLS.

WHEREAS, unplugged abandoned wells and improperly constructed wells are a potential source of contamination of groundwater and public and private water supplies, and

WHEREAS adoption of the applicable state standards by ordinance is required for participation in Iowa's grants-to-counties program to fund private well testing and private abandoned well plugging cost-sharing programs,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Iowa Administrative Code Chapters 567-39, regarding the plugging of abandoned wells, and 567-49, regarding the construction of private water wells, are hereby adopted by reference.
