JACKSON COUNTY ORDINANCE # 85

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE JACKSON COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 3.3 OF THE ORDINANCE TO CLARIFY PROVISIONS REGARDING PROCESSING, RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

The text of the Jackson County Zoning Ordinance in section 1.7, Schedules of district regulations, Special Exception Uses and Structures #6 in the A-1 Agricultural District and #2 in the M-2 General Industrial District shall each be changed to read as follows:

"Sanitary landfills, sanitary transfer stations, sanitary composting facilities, and sanitary recycling operations provided that no such operation shall be located closer than 1,000 feet to any dwelling, park or school. Such site shall be restored to a condition compatible with the adjacent area upon the conclusion of the operation."
