Interim Drug Free Communities Coordinator Julia Furne updated the Board.

Motion Steines, second Flagel to approve and authorize Chair signature on the addendum to contract between Jackson County and Julia Furne DBA Upstream Solutions LLC for an additional 30 hours for the month of July, 2026 for \$78.75 per hour as presented. Aye: Schwenker, Steines, Flagel

Veterans Affairs Administrator Ruth Eltrich updated the Board.

Engineer Jayden Scheckel presented county business.

Scheckel presented previously opened FY27 bids for gasoline, diesel fuel and additive. River Valley Energy bid \$0.319 for 35,000 gallons of ethanol blend gasoline; \$0.085 for 65,000 gallons of No. 2 regular diesel fuel; \$0.159 for winter blend diesel fuel; and \$.02 for 105,000 gallons of diesel fuel additive. Mulgrew Oil Co bid \$0.36 for 35,000 gallons of ethanol blend gasoline; \$0.022 for 65,000 gallons of No. 2 regular diesel fuel; \$0.22 for winter blend diesel fuel; and \$0.01 for 105,000 gallons of diesel fuel additive. AgVantage FS, Inc and Eastern Iowa LP did not bid.

Motion Flagel, second Steines to approve and authorize Chair signature on the contract with River Valley Energy for gasoline, diesel fuel and additive as presented. Aye: Schwenker, Steines, Flagel

Scheckel presented previously opened FY27 bids for 9,000 gallons of liquid propane (LP) gas. AgVantage FS bid \$1.179 and Mulgrew Oil Co bid \$1.325. River Valley Energy and Eastern Iowa LP did not bid.
