NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jackson County Board of Supervisors that the following portion of the following described secondary road situated in Jackson County, Iowa to-wit:

A parcel of land located in the SW1/4 of sec. 13, T86N, R4E of the 5th P.M., in Jackson County, Iowa, lying on the northeasterly side of a line described as follows: Commencing at a point 1253.0 ft. north of the SW corner of sec. 13, and on the centerline of Secondary Road D-61; thence along said centerline N82°47'E 423.41 ft.; thence easterly 641.99 ft. along a 1145.92 ft. radius curve concave southerly; thence N24°52'58"E 56.5 ft. to the point of beginning, and on the re-located northeasterly right of way line of said Secondary Road D-61; thence along said right of way line S65°20'01"E 642.0 ft., containing 0.19 acres, more or less.
