

RESOLUTION #143-30-87

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Auditor to issue county warrants without the approval of the Board of Supervisors on payment of freight, postage, drayage, payrolls, water, light, telephone or contractual services, witness fees and mileage. The bills paid by the Auditor without the approval of the Board of Supervisors shall be submitted to the Board for review and approval at its next meeting when claims are paid. The action of the Board shall be recorded in the minutes of the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Auditor may issue county warrants in fiscal 1987-88 without prior approval of the Board in payment of freight, postage, drayage, payrolls, water, light, telephone or contractual services, witness fees and mileage. The bills paid by the Auditor without the approval of the Board shall be submitted to the Board for review and approval at its next meeting when claims are paid. The action of the Board shall be recorded in the minutes of the Board. This resolution is in accordance with Section 331.506 of the Code of Iowa.


The above and foregoing resolution was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County, Iowa, on June 30, 1987.
