

RESOLUTION #192-23-90

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board of Supervisors received for their approval the rules of the Jackson County Board of Health setting fees for various permits, licenses and certifications issued by the Jackson County Health Department.

RULES OF THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH SETTING FEES FOR VARIOUS PERMITS, LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS ISSUED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

1. The following fees are hereby set by the Jackson County Board of Health:

\$50 - annual licensure as an installer of onsite wastewater treatment and disposal systems
\$40 - application fee for private well permits
\$40 - application fee for onsite wastewater treatment and disposal system permits
\$15 - application fee for onsite wastewater treatment and disposal system permit renewal or for installations involving only septic tank replacement or connection to an existing system.
In addition, fee for certification by the Health Officer of proper plugging of an abandoned well by the owner shall be the actual cost to the department for personnel time and travel.

2. These rules will be effective upon approval by resolution of the Jackson County Board of Supervisors and official publication as required by the Iowa Code section 137.6.

Adopted by unanimous vote of the Jackson County Board of Health at their meeting October 8, 1990 following a public hearing held October 8, 1990 with notice published as required:
