RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE QUESTION OF WHETHER TO ASSESS A HOTEL AND MOTEL TAX BE PLACED ON THE NOVEMBER 4TH GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT

BE IT RESOLVED by the Jackson County Board of Supervisors:

Section 1. The County Commissioner of Elections of Jackson County is hereby directed to give notice of and conduct an election to be held at the same time as the regular general election on November 4, 1986, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the county the following proposition:

"Shall Jackson County be authorized to impose a hotel and motel tax at the rate of 5 percent as provided by Chapter 422A of the Code of Iowa in accordance with the terms and provisions of a certain ordinance of Jackson County?"

Section 2. The voting places for said election shall be as set forth in a Notice of Special Election to be given by the Commissioner of Elections of Jackson County, Iowa. The polls shall be open on said day from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Section 3. That the Election Board for the voting precinct or precincts shall be appointed by the County Commissioner of Elections, not less than 15 days before the date of said election, a certified copy of which appointment shall be officially placed on file in the office of the County Auditor.

That the Auditor of Jackson County, Iowa, being the Section 4. County Commissioner of Elections, is hereby directed to publish the "Notice and Proclamation of Election" in the official papers of Jackson County at least once, not less than four or more than 20 days prior to the date of said election.

Section 5. That the Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution in the office of the County Commissioner of Elections.

Section 6. If said proposition is approved by a majority of the voters who voted thereon, the Hotel and Motel Tax shall be established on April 1, 1987.
