

**RESOLUTION FOR DISBURSING FEDERAL REVENUES COLLECTED  
FROM LEASING PROPERTY ALONG MISSISSIPPI RIVER**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Federal Government annually distributes funds to Jackson County, Iowa, from flood control revenues generated from real estate leases to private citizens along the Mississippi River, and said revenues are to be distributed according to Chapter 161E, 2004 Code of Iowa.

**WHEREAS**, said law mandates that 65% of the funds shall be allocated to schools in the said flood district areas, 25% of the funds shall be allocated to Secondary Roads and 10% of the funds shall be allocated to fire departments;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the \$60,394.18 received from the Treasurer, State of Iowa, on behalf of the Federal Government be distributed to the various identified entities as follows:
