

RESOLUTION NO. 228-08-20-96

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board of Supervisors, per Code of Iowa 1995, Section 331.361, did publish notice of a public hearing in the official county newspapers and said notice did specify that said public hearing would be conducted at 10:00 A.M. on August 20, 1996, during the regular scheduled Board meeting regarding the granting of a septic tank drainage field easement encumbering the property known as the Old Green Island City Hall as legally described in the notice of public hearing; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held at said time and date to discuss the granting of a permanent easement encumbering certain public real estate held by Jackson County as a result of the disincorporation of the City of Green Island; and

WHEREAS, there were no objections from the general public or other County Officials on the granting of said easement;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a permanent easement shall be granted to the Congregational Church of Green Island for the purpose of a septic tank drainage field on the west half of the real estate known as the Old Green Island City Hall as described in the Notice of Public Hearing, and that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to sign said easement.
