A RESOLUTION URGING REPEAL OF THE RESIDENCY
REQUIREMENT IN IOWA CODE SECTION 692A.2A

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Jackson,
Iowa, has considered the issues of ineffectiveness and expenditure of law enforcement
resources related to sex offender residency restrictions, and

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Attorneys Association, the Iowa Sheriffs
and Deputies Association, the Iowa Coalition Against Sexual Abuse, the Prevent Child
Abuse Iowa organization, the Iowa State Association of Counties, and not less than
eleven other professional Iowa groups and associations support repeal, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Jackson
desires to express its support for the repeal of Iowa Code Section 692A.2A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of
the County of Jackson, Iowa:

Section 1: That that the Legislature of Iowa and the Governor of Iowa
should repeal Iowa Code Section 692A.2A.
