

RESOLUTION NO. 623-18-86

This Agreement is made and entered into between Jackson County and other local governments in Cedar, Clinton, Delaware, Dubuque and Jackson Counties under and in compliance with Chapter 28E of the Code of Iowa.

WHEREAS, the Farmers Home Administration has announced the availability of grant funds under its Housing Preservation Grant Program, and


WHEREAS, a consortium of units of governments is an eligible applicant, and

WHEREAS, a legal entity such as a regional planning agency, or council of governments may be designated to be the applicant for the program,

THEREFORE BE IT AGREED between Jackson County and the other governments executing this same agreement:

1. The purpose of this agreement is to form a consortium and designate the East Central Intergovernmental Association (ECIA) to be the Applicant for and administrator of Farmers Home Administration Housing Preservation funds.
2. Effective date: The agreement shall take effect upon approval of the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County.
3. Duration. This agreement shall be indefinite unless the county or ECIA gives the other party 30 days notice in writing.
4. No separate legal entity is created under this agreement. No property will be acquired under this agreement.
5. The East Central Intergovernmental Association, a regional planning commission and council of governments for this jurisdiction, is hereby designated to be the applicant, grant recipient and grant administrator of the Farmers Home Administration Housing Preservation Program in the jurisdiction of Jackson County.
6. The financing of the program and administration will be provided by the Farmers Home Administration Housing Preservation Program.
