PREFERENCE FOR JACKSON COUNTY VENDORS

WHEREAS, a strong local business community is essential to the maintenance of a high standard of living in rural counties such as Jackson;




WHEREAS, the present depression in agriculture has placed extreme pressure on Jackson County businesses after placing them at a disadvantage due to decreased sales and increased overhead;

AND WHEREAS, we too often overlook the detrimental long-term effect to our area when we make purchases outside our county.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Jackson County Board of Supervisors that every Jackson County commission, board, committee, office or other governmental body of the county, and every person acting as a contracting or purchasing agent for the above shall give preference to Jackson County vendors as suppliers to Jackson County.

This preference shall apply in all cases where the vendors and products are readily available and are of a quality reasonably suited to the purpose intended and can be secured at a reasonable price.
