## AWARDING OF TSIP PORTABLE TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNAL L-TSF-C049(100)—74-49

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2025, the Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as "The Board", approved and authorized Funding Agreement No. 2026-TS-028 from the Iowa Department of Transportation in the amount of up to \$50,000 for the purchasing of a portable temporary traffic signal, hereafter referred to as "The Project"; and

WHEREAS, after consultation with the Iowa Department of Transportation, good faith efforts were performed to solicit quotes from Targeted Small Business (TSB); and

WHEREAS, no quotes were received from Targeted Small Business (TSB).

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by The Board to accept the lowest responsible quote from OMJC Signal in the amount of \$52,000.00 and awards the associated purchase order to the same; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution or action of the Board as a whole or any part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as provided by law.
