RESOLUTION FOR DISBURSING FEDERAL REVENUES COLLECTED FROM LEASING PROPERTY ALONG MISSISSIPPI RIVER

WHEREAS, the U.S. Federal Government annually distributes funds to Jackson County, Iowa, from flood control revenues generated from real estate leases to private citizens along the Mississippi River, and said revenues are to be distributed according to Chapter 161E, Code of Iowa.

WHEREAS, said law mandates that 65% of the funds shall be allocated to schools in the said flood district areas, 25% of the funds shall be allocated to Secondary Roads and 10% of the funds shall be allocated to fire departments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the \$99,426.01 received from the Treasurer, State of Iowa, on behalf of the Federal Government be distributed to the various identified entities as follows:

Bellevue Fire Department (Town of Bellevue)	\$ 4,971.31
Sabula Fire Department (Town of Sabula)	\$ 2,485.65
Miles Benefited Fire Department	\$ 2,485.65
Total Allocated	\$99,426.01
