WHEREAS, economic development representatives from Cedar County, Clinton County, Jackson County, Muscatine County and Scott County are in the process of establishing a regional alliance for marketing the five counties to attract quality new business and high quality jobs; and

WHEREAS, to achieve this goal, the partner organization commit to working together as the Eastern Iowa Economic Development Regional Alliance; and

WHEREAS, Jackson County Board of Supervisors has been invited to participate in the Alliance; and


WHEREAS, the Eastern Iowa Economic Development Alliance is requesting a maximum contribution from Jackson County in the amount of \$2,606.45 in order to meet the matching requirements of a grant application being submitted to the State of Iowa Department of Economic Development. Upon approval of the grant application, the funds committed would leverage \$112,000 in total for the Eastern Iowa Economic Development Regional Alliance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THAT:

1. The Board of Supervisors supports the Eastern Iowa Economic Development Alliance and wishes to participate as a member of the Alliance; and
2. The Board of Supervisors will contribute at a maximum \$2,606.45 as matching funds to support the grant application being submitted to the Iowa Department of Economic Development; and
3. The Chairperson is hereby directed and authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of Jackson County
