A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE JACKSON COUNTY JOINT 911 SERVICE BOARD.

WHEREAS, Chapter 477B, Code of Iowa, 1988 requires the Board of Supervisors of each county establish a "Joint 911 Service Board" not later than January 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Jackson County, in compliance with Chapter 477B, will establish the Jackson County Joint 911 Service Board and will establish voting membership on the Joint 911 Service Board to each "political subdivision of the state having a public safety agency serving territory within" Jackson County; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board of Supervisors has called an organizational meeting of the Joint 911 Service Board for November 22, 1988, at 7:30 p.m. in the Community Room of the Jackson County Courthouse.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THAT THE JOINT 911 SERVICE BOARD FOR JACKSON COUNTY IS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF IOWA CODE SECTION 477B.
