.BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed Fiscal Year 2005/2006 budget be officially adopted and certified as presented at hearing and hereby authorize said Board to sign all required forms and authorize Auditor Deppe to forward all forms as required to the Iowa Department of Management and to include salaries of the auditor, treasurer, attorney and supervisors at 2.5% and the recorder and sheriff at 4% instead of the 5% and 8%, respectively, recommended increases as stated in a letter from the Compensation Board as follows:
