A RESOLUTION RELEASING A SECURITY INTEREST FOR  
DEERBROOK ESTATES FIRST ADDITION


WHEREAS, the plat of Deerbrook Estates First Addition, a subdivision of the Southeast Quarter of section 9 of South Fork Township, has been approved and recorded, and

WHEREAS, to secure proper completion of silt fence, seeding, and mulching associated with the initial grading of the developed area and construction of the private subdivision road 69th Street, the County accepted a security interest in a Certificate of Deposit in the amount of \$4187.37, and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has on September 18, 2000 inspected the erosion control work secured by that Certificate and has reported that the seeding is well established with the exception of a small area near the tree line at the access to the common nature area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, that the County's security interest detailed above be relinquished and we hereby direct the County Auditor to return to the developer all related documents. It is noted that the developer has agreed to seed and mulch the area referred to above within the next week.

The chairman of the Board of Supervisors is hereby directed to certify this resolution, passed, approved, and adopted this 19th day of September, 2000.
