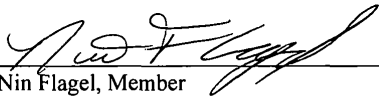

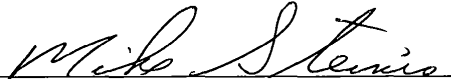
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Jackson County Board of Supervisors approve the above resolution this 23rd day of June, 2026.

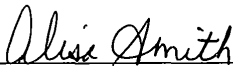
