AWARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT ON 17TH ST LFM-IA3320—7X-49

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as "The Board", believes the LFM-IA3320—7X-49, hereafter referred to as "The Project" is in the best interest of Jackson County, Iowa, and the residents thereof. The project is defined as bridge replacement on 17th Street over the creek, S33 T84 R6E; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 26.12, a public hearing was held on February 10, 2026 to approve the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and cost estimate for The Project; and

WHEREAS, a resolution was adopted by the Board on February 10, 2026 approving the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and cost estimate for The Project; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 26.3, a Notice to Bidders was advertised for sealed bids for The Project on February 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 26.10, a public bid opening for The Project was conducted on February 26, 2026 at 10:00 AM in the office of the County Engineer at 201 West Platt Street, Maquoketa, Iowa, and the following bids were received:

Jim Schroeder Construction, Inc. \$333,532.73

WHEREAS, The Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Jackson County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa.

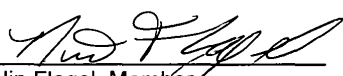

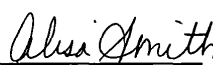
