AND, WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 331.323 (2) (d) allows the Board of Supervisors to

 been on file for more than five years and are not required as permanent records."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jackson County Board of Supervisors that it  
 authorizes the Jackson County Conservation Director to destroy the aforementioned records.
