

Resolution #17-10-09-01

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board of Supervisors, hereby affirms that Jackson County has only gained only 346 people according to the 2000 federal decennial census and;

WHEREAS, Chapter 49 of the 2001 Code of Iowa, as amended requires that election precincts shall be drawn by the county board of supervisors, if necessary, as soon as possible after the redistricting of congressional and legislative districts becomes law and;

WHEREAS, the population totals within the current election precincts has not changed enough to warrant any changes in the current 16 election precincts and;

WHEREAS, a signed letter of agreement has be approved between the City of Bellevue and Jackson County, to retain the 1st Precinct composed of the City of Bellevue and Bellevue Township as required by Chapter 49.3 of the 2001 Code of Iowa, as amended and ;

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE JACKSON COUNTY SUPERVISORS AND THE CITY OF BELLEVUE TO COMBINE CITY OF BELLEVUE AND BELLEVUE TOWNSHIP INTO SINGLE VOTING PRESCINCT


WHEREAS, Chapter 49.6, 2001 Code of Iowa, as amended, requires a signed agreement between the Board of Supervisors and a city of 2,000 or more in population in order to combine a township and city precinct; and


WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has been combined with Bellevue Township for the last ten years, saving the taxpayers of Jackson County the expense of running two polling locations at the same time in the City of Bellevue, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 49.3, 2001 Code of Iowa, as amended, grants the county and cities of 2,000 in population the power to combine township and city precincts as long as the combined precinct does not have a total population in excess of three thousand five hundred, as shown by the most recent federal decennial census, and the combined precinct is contained wholly within a legislative district; and

WHEREAS, it is agreed that the City of Bellevue and Bellevue Township shall be combined together to be the First Precinct in county-wide elections, since the total populations (2,951) does not exceed 3,500 and the precinct is wholly in the 25th Legislative District;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that the City Council of the City of Bellevue and the Board of Supervisors of Jackson County, Iowa, do hereby agree to create the First Precinct composed of the City of Bellevue and Bellevue Township effective until the next federal decennial census.






