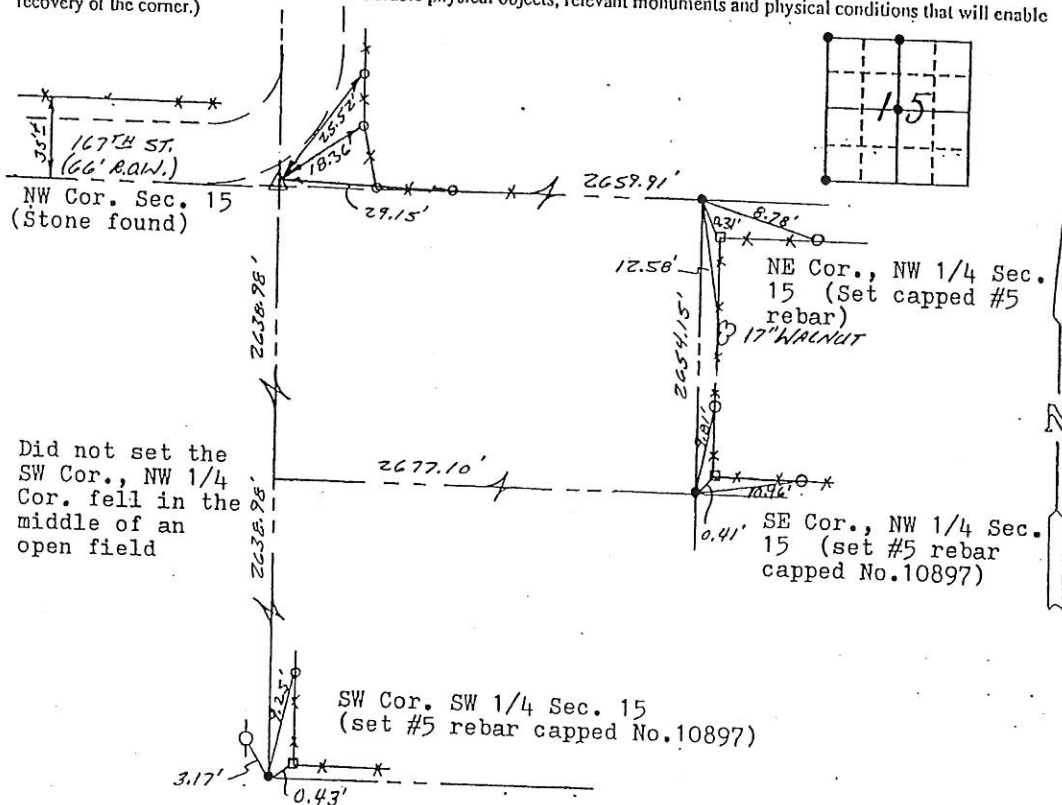

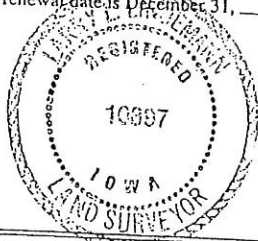

NW COR CONT. I found the found stone to be in harmony with existing fences and roads. During my diligent field search I found nothing to dispute the location of said stone and therefor accepted it as the NW corner monument.

NE COR., NW 1/4- I set a capped #5 rebar at the N. 1/4 Cor. at the intersection of two fences. I received verbal evidence from long standing residents that the fences have been in their present location for many years and have been accepted as section line and boundary line as long as memory served. The old barbed wire imbedded in the old existing trees also gave credence to the fences being ancient.

SE COR., NW 1/4- I set a capped #5 rebar at the center of the section at the corner of intersecting fences. I made my decision to accept the fence location after talking to long time residents of the area and finding that the fences have been in the same location for many years and have been accepted as the section and deed lines for generations. Although this location does not match the theoretical center of section I feel that the location chosen fits in harmony with the local assumptions by the residents and is not in dispute with any other evidence found. I see no evidence that changing this location would benefit anyone.

SW COR., SEC. 15- Set a capped #5 rebar at an existing ancient fence corner. I found no evidence of any other monumentation in the area to mark the location of this corner nor did I find any evidence to dispute the location of the existing fence.

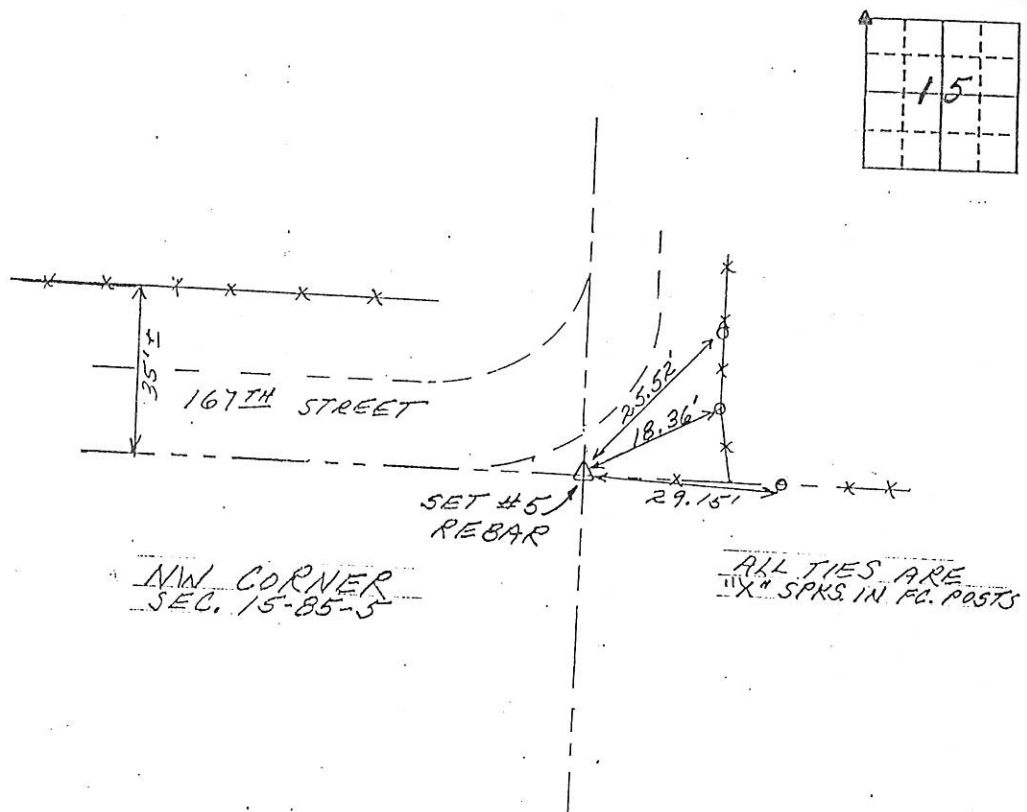
