

NOTICE OF VACANCIES

The Jackson County Board of Supervisors is taking applications for various county board and commission appointments. Jackson County appreciates diversity in these appointments and welcomes all applicants at least 18 years of age. Terms and dates of appointments vary for these unpaid positions. A brief description follows:

Planning & Zoning Commission: Five-member commission to review and enforce the county zoning ordinance and make recommendations on any proposed changes.

Board of Adjustment: Five-member board may, in appropriate cases, make special exceptions to the terms of the Zoning ordinance or regulations.

Veteran Affairs Commission: Five-member commission to provide guidance and oversee operations of Veteran Affairs department.

Pioneer Cemetery Commission: Nine-member commission responsible for the care and maintenance of the Pioneer Cemeteries in the county.

Historic Preservation Commission: Seven-member commission responsible to safeguard the County's historic, aesthetic and cultural heritage by preserving sites and districts of historic and cultural significance
